

### Investment strategy

The fund is actively managed and invests at least two-thirds of its assets in inflation-linked bonds with an investment grade or sub-investment grade credit rating (as measured by Standard & Poor's or any equivalent grade of other credit rating agencies for rated bonds and implied Schroders ratings for nonrated bonds) issued by governments, government agencies, supra-nationals and companies worldwide. Inflation-linked bonds provide protection against the effects of rising prices as generally both the value of the original amount borrowed and the interest payments move in line with consumer prices.

### Investment goal

The fund aims to provide capital growth and income in excess of the ICE BofA Global Governments Inflation-Linked EUR Hedged Index after fees have been deducted over a three to five year period by investing in inflation-linked bonds.
