







The investment manager may invest in issuers with any environmental, social, and governance (ESG) profile. It methodically exercises voting rights and may engage with issuers in order to positively influence ESG practices.

The Compartment mainly invests in a broad range of corporate financial financial and government bonds, including securities and loans from issuers who have failed to make scheduled payments or are in, or near, bankruptcy (distressed and defaulted securities). The Compartment mainly invests in Europe, and can invest across any sector, credit quality and currency.
