Objectives and investment policy


The fund is actively managed without reference to an index. The Fund seeks to increase the value of its assets over the medium term by using asset allocation strategies across all types of asset classes, such as shares, debt securities, derivatives, money market instruments and cash. The allocation between the different asset classes listed above is fixed over the medium period. For each allocation, a maximum leverage is defined in order to protect the shareholder from an extreme drawdown.

This shall result in a diversified portfolio and the Fund may only use long positions, but can create leverage through derivatives while seeking to maintain the VaR of the portfolio close to 17.5%.

Incomes are systematically reinvested.

Investors are able to redeem on a daily basis (on Luxembourg bank business days) as described in the prospectus.

Risk and reward profile

Other risks materially relevant to the Fund which are not adequately captured by the indicator are described below:

- <u>Credit Risk</u>: This risk relates to the ability of an issuer to honour its commitments: downgrades of an issue or issuer rating may lead to a drop in the value of associated bonds.
- <u>Counterparty Risk</u>: This risk is associated with the ability of a counterparty in an Over The Counter financial transaction to fulfil its commitments like payment, delivery and reimbursement.
- <u>Operational and Custody Risk</u>: Some markets are less regulated than most of the international markets; hence, the services related to custody and liquidation for the subfund on such markets could be more risky.
- <u>Derivatives Risk</u>: When investing in over the counter or listed derivatives, the Fund aims to hedge and/or to leverage the yield of its position. The attention of the investor is drawn to the fact that leverage increases the volatility of the subfund.
