Objectives and investment policy

The fund is actively managed. The fund is not managed in reference to a benchmark. The objective of the investment policy is to generate a return in euro. To achieve this, the fund invests floating rate bonds, with a focus on investment grade securities. Furthermore, the sub-fund's assets may be invested in convertible bonds or fixed rate bonds. When selecting suitable investments, environmental and social aspects and the principles of good corporate governance (ESG criteria) are taken into consideration. These aspects are of essential importance for the investment

strategy. Furthermore, derivatives may be used for portfolio management. The selection of the individual investments is at the discretion of the fund management. The currency of the fund is EUR. Returns and gains are not distributed but are reinvested in the fund. You may request the redemption of shares generally on a daily basis. The Company may, however, suspend or restrict the redemption if extraordinary circumstances appear to make this necessary, taking into account the interests of the investors.

Risk and reward profile



The calculation of the risk and reward profile is based on historical data that cannot be used as a reliable indicator for the future risk

profile. This risk indicator is subject to changes; the classification of the fund may change over time and cannot be guaranteed. Even a fund that is classified in the lowest category (category 1) does not represent a completely risk-free investment. The fund is classified in category 2 because its share price generally fluctuates very little and the likelihood of both losses and gains should therefore be relatively low.

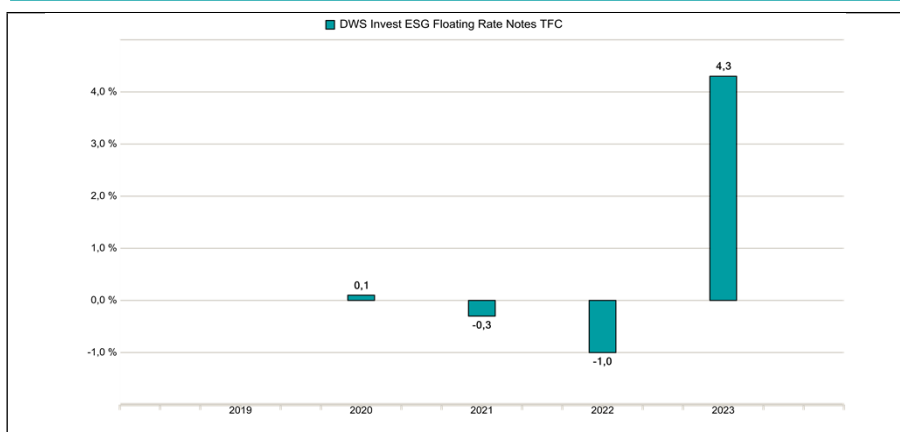
The charges you pay are used to pay the costs of running the fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.
