What is this product?

Type

This product is a Class of Unit of the sub-fund Euro Cash (the "Fund") which is part of Epsilon Fund, an open-ended common fund in transferable securities ("FCP") qualifying as a UCITS.

Term

There is no maturity date for this product. The product could be unilaterally closed or merged following notice to investors in the conditions led down in the Prospectus.

Objectives

Investment objective To preserve your investment while achieving a return that is in line with that of the euro money market rate.

Note that money invested in this fund may gain or lose value. The fund may not protect you from investment losses and does not guarantee any particular level of return. It is not equivalent to a bank deposit and does not have any external support that guarantees its liquidity or stabilises its NAV. Any investor in the fund must be prepared to bear any losses

Benchmark(s) Bloomberg Euro Treasury Bills Index® (total return). The benchmark does not take into account ESG criteria. For designing the portfolio and measuring performance.

Investment policies The fund mainly invests in investment grade short-term bonds. These investments are mainly denominated in euro. The fund generally favours direct investment but may at times invest through derivatives.

Specifically, the fund normally invests at least 80% of total net assets in investment grade debt and debt-related instruments, including money market instruments, denominated in EUR and deposits, and a least 7.5% and 15% in assets maturing within one day and 5 days (including deposits), respectively.

The fund may invest in the following asset classes up to the percentages of total net assets indicated:

■ units of UCITS and other UCIs: 10%

Portfolio weighted average maturity 6 months or less. Weighted average life 12 months or less.

The fund does not invest in asset-backed and mortgage-backed

securities.

Non-EUR investments are hedged to EUR.

Strategy In actively managing the fund, the investment manager uses interest rate and duration analysis and independently evaluates issuer credit quality to seek high current yields (topdown and bottom-up approach). The fund's exposure to securities, and thus its performance, are likely to differ slightly from those of the benchmark.

Distribution Policy This Unit Class is not distributing dividends. Income from investments is reinvested.

Other information The fund has (E) environmental and (S) social characteristics and promotes investment into assets which follow good governance (G) practices in accordance with article 8 of the Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation ("SFDR"). 

Risks

What happens if Eurizon Capital S.A. is unable to pay out?

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?
