Objectives and Investment Policy

Objective: The fund aims to achieve capital growth over the long term.

Investment Policy: The fund invests at least 70% of its assets, in equities of, and related instruments providing exposure to, companies that have their head office in, are listed in or exercise a predominant part of their activity in Europe. The fund may also invest in Money Market Instruments on an ancillary basis. The fund invests at least 50% of its assets in securities of companies with favourable environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics.

The fund aims to outperform the benchmark.

Investment Process: In actively managing the fund, the investment manager considers valuation metrics, company financials, return on capital, cash flows and other measures, as well as company management, industry, economic conditions, and other characteristics. The Investment Manager also considers ESG characteristics when assessing investment risks and opportunities. In determining favourable ESG characteristics, the Investment Manager takes into account ESG ratings provided by Fidelity or external agencies. Through the investment management process the Investment Manager aims to ensure that investee companies follow good governance practices. The fund adheres to the Fidelity Sustainable Family of Funds standards. For more information, see "Sustainable Investing and ESG Integration" and the Sustainability Annex sections of the Prospectus.

Derivatives and Techniques: The fund may use derivatives for hedging, efficient portfolio management and investment purposes. The fund uses derivatives, including complex derivative instruments or strategies, to meet the investment objectives of the fund which may result in leverage. The fund may maintain long and short exposure to securities through derivatives.

Benchmark: MSCI Europe Index an index that does not take into account ESG characteristics. Used for: investment selection, risk monitoring, and performance comparison.

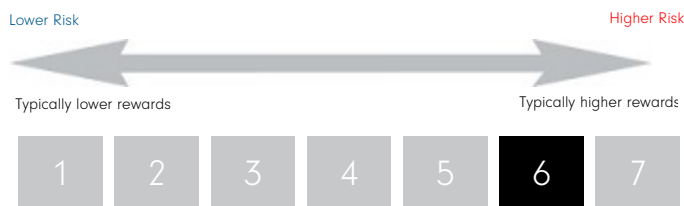
The fund invests in securities of the benchmark, however, the management of the fund is discretionary, therefore the fund may invest in securities not included in the benchmark, and its performance over any period may or may not deviate significantly from that of the benchmark.

Risk Management Method: Relative VaR. Expected gross leverage: 200% (may be higher or lower but not expected to exceed 250%).

Base Currency: EUR

Distribution: As this is a non-distributing share class, dividends are re-invested.

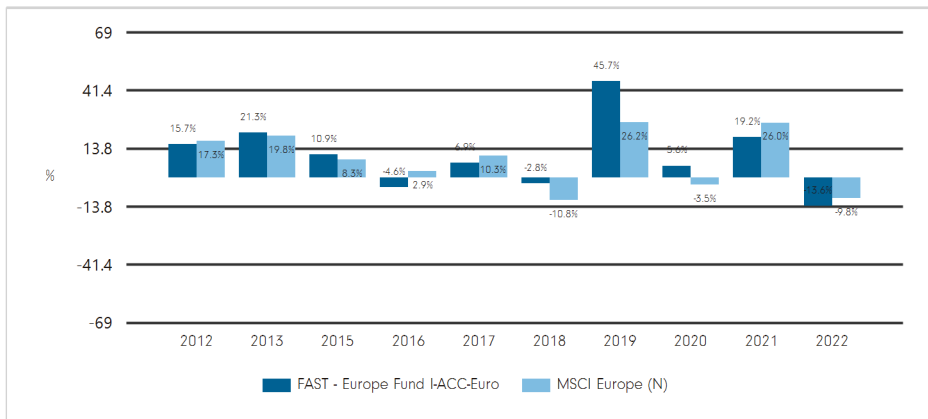
