## What is this product?

### TYPE OF PRODUCT

The product is a sub-fund of Manavest, an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

### TERM

The Sub-Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However, the board of directors may decide to close this product under certain circumstances.

### OBJECTIVES

#### Objectives and investment policy

The Sub-Fund seeks to provide medium-term capital appreciation.

The Sub-Fund will have the structure of a fund of funds and will mainly invest in UCIs selected on the basis of their overall quality and investment opportunities, which mainly invest in equity and equity related securities.

The UCIs will pursue varying strategies comprising, amongst others, Long only equity, Equity long short, Equity market neutral, global macro and CTA (trend followers).

The UCIs will not be limited to a particular style (traditional or UCITS eligible alternative funds), geographical exposure, sector of economic activity or a given currency. However, depending on market conditions, the exposure may be focused on one country or on a limited number of emerging countries and/or one economic activity sector and/or one currency.

The Sub-Fund may invest up to 49% of its net assets in any other type of eligible assets, UCIs with other underlying investments than those above mentioned, equities, debt instruments, Structured Products, Money Market Instruments and money market UCIs.

**Derivatives** For hedging and for investment purposes, the Sub-Fund may use all types of financial derivative instruments traded on a Regulated Market and/or OTC Derivatives provided they are contracted with leading financial institutions specialised in this type of transactions and subject to regulatory supervision. Nevertheless, in normal market conditions, the Investment Manager intends to use options and futures offering an exposure to equities and currency derivatives (such as forward foreign exchange contracts).

**Benchmark** The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The benchmark index of the Sub-Fund is UCITS Hedge Fund Composite Index. It is mentioned only for information purposes and the Sub-Fund does not track the index. The Sub-Fund can deviate significantly from the benchmark index.

**Dividend Policy** This Class is cumulative. Dividend distributions are not planned.

**Share Class Currency** The currency of the Class is CHF.

The recommended holding period of this product is determined to allow sufficient time for this product to reach its objectives and avoiding short term market fluctuations.

The return of the product is determined using the Net Asset Value (the "NAV") calculated by the Central administration. This return depends mainly on the market value fluctuations of the underlying investments.

### INTENDED RETAIL INVESTORS

The product is suitable for retail investors with limited knowledge of the underlying financial instruments and no financial industry experience. The product is compatible with investors who may bear capital losses and who do not need capital guarantee. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 5 years.

**Depository** Pictet & Cie (Europe) S.A. (the "Depository").

**Asset segregation** The assets and liabilities of each sub-fund are segregated by law, which means that the performance of the assets in other sub-funds does not influence the performance of your investment.

**Dealing** The Net Asset Value for the Class is priced on each Friday. The cut-off time to submit subscriptions and/or redemptions orders is 12 noon Luxembourg time 6 business days preceding the relevant pricing day.

**Switching** Shareholders may apply for any share of any sub-fund or class to be converted into shares of another sub-fund or class, provided that the conditions for accessing the target class, are fulfilled, on the basis of their respective Net Asset Value calculated on the valuation day following receipt of the conversion request. The redemption and subscription costs connected with the conversion may be charged to the shareholder as indicated in the prospectus. ## What happens if FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A. is unable to pay out?

The Management Company is not making any payment to you in relation to the Sub-Fund and you would still be paid in case of a default from the Management Company.

The Sub-Fund's assets are held with a separate company, the Depository, so the Sub-Fund's ability to pay out would not be affected by the insolvency of the Management Company. However, in the event of the Depository's insolvency, or its delegates, the Sub-Fund may suffer a financial loss. However, this risk is mitigated to a certain extent by the fact the Depository is required by law and regulation to segregate its own assets from the assets of the Sub-Fund. The Depository will also be liable to the Sub-Fund or its investors for any loss arising from, among other things, its negligence, fraud or intentional failure properly to fulfill its obligations (subject to certain limitations).

If the Sub-Fund is terminated or wound up, the assets will be liquidated and you will receive an appropriate share of any proceeds but you may lose part or all of your investment.

There is no compensation or guarantee scheme protecting you from a default of the Depository.

## What are the costs?

### Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.
